Important Weather Related Announcements from the Town of Pike Road

"During the next few days, The Town of Pike Road would like to encourage all residents to use caution and to stay in touch with local weather authorities for updates. While the exact path of Hurricane Irma is still unknown, it is likely that we will feel the impact. Therefore, please make appropriate preparations. We want all of our residents to be safe," said Gordon Stone, Mayor.

Important Information:

Due to the predicted inclement weather, Pike Road Town Hall offices will close at 11 a.m. on Monday, September 11 and plan to reopen on Tuesday, September 12 at 10 a.m., unless otherwise noted on our webpage, www.pikeroad.us.

The Town Council and Planning Commission meetings scheduled for the evening of Monday, September 11 have been postponed. We will share information on the re-schedule dates of these events when they are determined.

In addition, Pike Road Schools will be closed Monday, September 11 and Tuesday, September 12. All after-school meetings and activities have also been cancelled.

Pike Road Elementary School, located at 500 Avenue of Learning, will be open as a storm shelter from 10 a.m. on Monday, September 11 until 12 p.m. on Tuesday, September 12. Please bring supplies for the time at the shelter: food, bedding, personal hygiene items and other necessities.

The National Weather Service has indicated wind and flooding to be the greatest threats to our area. It is a good idea to keep cell phones handy and well charged. For other weather preparedness tips, visit <https://www.ready.gov/>.
