PIKE ROAD VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT BOOT DRIVE JULY 16

The Pike Road Volunteer Fire Department (PRVFD) will kick off its first-ever Boot Drive this Saturday, July 16, with a “red light stop” at the intersection of Vaughn Road and Chantilly Parkway. Firefighters will be stationed at the intersection with boots, asking motorists to help fill the boots with cash to help fund muscular dystrophy research. The funds raised through the PRVFD Boot Drive will be donated to the Muscular Dystrophy Association.

John Scanlan, PRVFD Assistant Chief, said, “We want to help ‘Jerry’s Kids’ this year and as many more years as it takes to find a cure for M.D.”

Town of Pike Road Mayor Gordon Stone added, “The volunteers and staff of the Pike Road Volunteer Fire Department go beyond the call of duty to protect the citizens of this town. The MDA Boot Drive is further proof of their dedication to improving the lives of others, and the town is proud of the example this project sets for everyone in this community.”

The Pike Road Volunteer Fire Department is a combination department with both full-time personnel and 45 volunteer firefighters. PRVFD operates six stations and covers 94 square miles in the Town of Pike Road vicinity and holds an ISO rating of six. The Town of Pike Road supports the PRVFD through the collection of a five-mill property tax dedicated to the department. This is the only local property tax collected by the municipality.
