PIKE ROAD TOWN HALL MORE ACCESSIBLE, ACCOMMODATING

Pike Road Town Hall is currently undergoing improvements that will make it both more accessible and able to accommodate a broader range of activities. The addition of an elevator and third stairway improve access and traffic flow to facility's second floor. Once complete, improvements to the second floor will create a meeting and banquet space that can be used for community gatherings and social events. In addition to the accessibility improvements, the upstairs space will soon contain a stage and better access to the building's commercial kitchen, located on the first floor of the former grocery. The second floor currently contains several offices that will not be altered in the construction.

Town of Pike Road Mayor Gordon Stone said, "It has been a priority of the town to make the best use of all the square footage in the new town hall facility. These updates will allow the town to better utilize the second floor that was created during the original renovations of the space, as well as to ensure that all of our residents can access this new event venue."

Once construction is complete early this fall, the new meeting and banquet space on the second floor of Pike Road Town Hall will be available for public rental as well as official town use. The town plans to host a children's art show in the second floor space September 11.

Pike Road Town Hall is located at 9575 Vaughn Road, just east of the Vaughn Road-Pike Road intersection. The facility anchors the Pike Road Station commercial and municipal center. Town offices relocated to Pike Road Station in August 2010, after operating for more than a decade in the original town hall at 4902 Pike Road. The town owns the Pike Road Station center, which is also home to the Pike Road Branch Library and commercial tenants.
