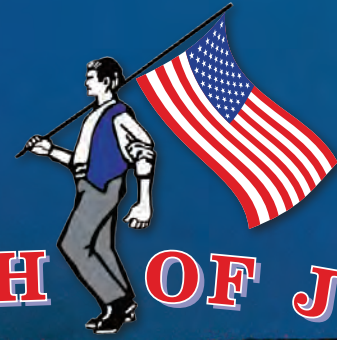




COME ONE, COME ALL
