## 2012 Arbor Day Poster Contest Entry Form for Fifth Grade Students

### Contest Rules:

- All entries must be original artwork created by a student who is **currently in the fifth grade**. A student may enter the contest only once.
- The student's first and last name must be written or signed in the lower right-hand corner on the front of the poster.
- Entries may be created using marker, crayon, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, colored pencil, and/or tempera paint.
  - Collages are not acceptable. (Do not glue anything on your poster.)
  - Computer or photo generated art and/or printing is not acceptable.
  - Entries should not display the names of commercial products, companies, or organizations.
- Entries must be no smaller than 8.5" x 11" and no larger than 14" x 18".
- Entries must be created on paper that will allow for duplication, display and framing.
- The poster must be related to the contest theme in some way. The theme is "Trees are Terrific... and Forests are Too!"
- The theme, "Trees are Terrific... and Forests are Too!" must be on the poster, and all words must be spelled correctly.
- Entries should not be matted, mounted, laminated, framed, or folded.
