



Disaster Assistance Now Available

If you sustained losses or damage in Autauga, Elmore, or Montgomery counties during the severe storms of May 6 – 8, you may be eligible for federal and state disaster aid.

FEMA's temporary housing assistance and grants for public transportation expenses, medical and dental expenses, and funeral and burial expenses do not require individuals to apply for an SBA loan. However, applicants who receive SBA loan applications must submit them to SBA loan officers to be eligible for assistance that covers personal property, vehicle repair or replacement, and moving and storage expenses.
