## PIKE ROAD VOTERS SAY “YES” TO SCHOOL

Voters in the Town of Pike Road went to the polls today to choose whether or not to increase property taxes within the town limits to fund the establishment of a municipal school system. Of the 49.5 percent of registered voters casting ballots in the election, 55.4 percent voted in favor of the town’s plan to provide a funding stream for the Pike Road school system.

“The result of today’s voting allows the people of Pike Road to move forward with the school plans that they have worked to develop for the last six years. It says that the people of the Town of Pike Road share the vision of a community school known for excellent, innovative teaching, discipline in the classroom and local control over education decisions,” said Mayor Gordon Stone. “I am so excited for the volunteers who have led this effort, and I am thankful for their commitment to our children’s future.”

Construction of the school is projected to begin in 2014, with doors opening on a K-8 facility in the fall of 2015. Before any of these steps take place, however, a school board must be appointed to carry out the work of the school system.

Quality in public education was identified as one of four “pillars” of citizens’ vision for the Town of Pike Road during a public visioning session in 2005. In 2006, a citizen committee was formed to begin researching the process of establishing a school system and identifying the best curriculum model for that system. The committee’s work forms the foundation of the Pike Road school plan, which is based on a Professional Development School model.
