Elliott in 1908 with a congregation of 19 members; and, with support from the Pike Road Methodist Church, the congregation grew, and the first church building was constructed on its present site in 1920; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pike Road Mayor and Town Council would like to extend their sincere congratulations to Pike Road Baptist Church upon their anniversary of 110 years of service, and recognize the contributions generations of its congregation have made to the Pike Road area community; and

WHEREAS, for 110 years, the Pike Road Baptist Church has enjoyed a historical and abundant existence, positively contributing to the well-being of the surrounding community, encouraging growth and providing opportunities for fellowship for all ages, and contributing to the Forgotten Children Ministries and The Community of Hope Outreach Center, among other charitable endeavors; and
