Critical Home Repair Program - Applications Open Oct. 16







The Critical Home Repair (CHR) Program is supported through the Montgomery Thrive Fiscal Recovery Fund of the American Rescue Plan Act and administered by the Central Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission (CARPDC). The program aims to support the increasing demand for emergency home repairs. It assists low/moderate-income owner-occupied households.

Eligible Properties and Repairs: Single-family [site built]* and qualifying manufactured housing, that are owner occupied and within the boundaries of Montgomery County, with critical structural repairs needed or conditions threatening the health and safety of the occupants, will be eligible for this program. This program is free to eligible homeowners on a first-come, first-served basis as long as funds remain available. Applications can be downloaded here or picked up at Pike Road Town Hall.
