Magazine-Worthy Container Gardens are Coming Soon to a Home Near You!



Our May 18 Container Gardening Ag & Stewardship Workshop was full of learning and laughter!

We had a great afternoon with Eric & Elizabeth Leatherwood from Leatherwood Nursery today. Here are a few tips from the Leatherwoods for creating your own magazine-worthy container garden at home:

Be aware of the environment your planter will be in plant in before getting started: Is it dry or wet, shady or sunny? This will help you

pick the right plants.

- For any decorative planter, think: Thriller (centerpiece), filler (accentuates the center plant), and spiller (a trailing plant around the edges).
- For a 360° viewable container, you want to have a vibrant and tall center to draw the eye in. For large 360° planters, use the rule of 3: A tall plant in the center (AKA "thrill"), then 3 smaller plants around it (fill) and 3 trailing plants around those (spill), window-pane style.
- For planters placed in front of a wall, situate your thrill in the back, your fill in the middle, and your spill around the outer edge. Consider doing everything in twos for balance.
