

Summer Feeding Program Feeds Hundreds - Thank You P.R.A.Y.E.R. Team!



It is amazing to see what can happen when communities come together! This summer, the P.R.A.Y.E.R. (Pike Road Area Your Emergency Response) Team, which involves local faith leaders working together to meet the needs of our community, designed and implemented a program to provide nutritional assistance to hundreds of families whose children face food insecurity during the summer months, when school meals were unavailable.

Together, our local churches recruited and organized over 150 volunteers who picked up, packed, and distributed pantry items and meals. Over a dozen faith and community organizations in the Town of Pike Road participated, and they served hundreds of families across Pike Road. We want to say thank you to every church and volunteer that helped make this program possible, including program coordinator Stacy Dickinson.
