

Submit Your Work Starting June 3!

- There is no fee for entry, and artists may enter up to two pieces of artwork. Submissions can be in any medium. Giclee prints of your original work are acceptable. We may not be able to accommodate very large entries. Artwork that is fragile or not fixed (pastel, wet paint) should be protected accordingly.
- You must price your art if you wish to offer it for sale. For each piece of art sold, the Town of Pike Road will collect a 15% commission on sales. Payment for sold artwork will be mailed to artists within 14 days of the close of the show.
- Art will be accepted at the Pike Road Arts Center beginning on June 3. The deadline to submit art is June 10. The Arts Center & Water House Gallery are open on Saturdays from 10 a.m. 4 p.m. and Sundays from 1 4 p.m. All unsold artworks must be picked up no later than July 31 at the Pike Road Arts Center.
- The Pike Road Arts Council reserves the right to exclude art not considered suitable.
