Fall events and activities are quickly approaching, and, as we move forward, please continue to be mindful of the risks of COVID-19, recognize the value of continuing to protect yourselves and others, and exercise personal responsibility. COVID-19 and, particularly, the Delta variant, are still active across Alabama. It is up to each of us to make smart, responsible decisions that help us maintain our forward progress in the fight to stop it so that we can continue to enjoy opportunities to gather and safely enjoy the company of family and friends.

At this time, in accordance with the latest guidelines and recommendations from local health care leaders and the CDC, the Town of Pike Road is requiring visitors at Town Hall and other municipal facilities to wear a mask regardless of vaccination status. LAST CHANCE: Register Now - Trail Cameras & Nature Photography Ag & Stewardship Workshop, 4 - 6 p.m. TODAY




