With the dawn of the New Year, we look forward to the days when COVID-19 is no longer part of our daily lives, However, as we enjoy all the opportunities that the coming year will offer, we encourage you to remember that COVID-19 is an ongoing challenge in our community and our state. Please continue to make smart, safe decisions as you celebrate all this time of year has to offer. One of the most effective tools to combat COVID-19 is vaccination. Initial vaccines and additional booster doses are free and readily available at multiple locations within our community, and individuals ages 5+ are eligible to receive the Pfizer vaccine. In addition, the Alabama Department of Public Health recommends that immunocompromised individuals receive a booster vaccine after they are fully vaccinated. Adults 18 and older are eligible to receive a booster dose six months after receiving their first Moderna or Pfizer shot, or two months after receiving the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
