## TOMORROW: New Workshop from the Pike Road Arts Council!



Join the Pike Road Arts Council for Glazing with Oil Paints with Charles Payne at the Pike Road Arts Center (944 Wallahatchie Rd)! Beginning tomorrow, March 30, and continuing on April 9, Charles will lead artists through the traditional technique of glazing, from start to finish.


Glazing is used to increase the depth and intensify colors in a painting, taking your art to the next level. Glazing with oil was around before the Renaissance, but it was not used for fine art. After Jan Van Eyck and Leonardo Da Vinci, glazing with oil paints became a common tool for painters. Together, participants will uncover these old techniques and how to use them effectively!

**Tomorrow, on March 30,** from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m., participants will create a grisaille. A grisaille is a painting executed entirely in shades of grey or another neutral color. March 30's class will focus on creating the illusion of form through light and shade, forming the basis for the glazing in week two.

A week later, on April 6, artists will reconvene from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. to glaze color onto the grisaille, bringing it to life. April 6's class will emphasize creating the illusion of form through light and shade.

There are registration fees associated with this workshop. The registration fee for this event is \$120 and includes the cost of all materials. There are only three available seats for this workshop! Don't miss your chance to participate - email\_patty@pikeroad.us to register today.

# Introduction to Perspectives on April 18 & 19: Register Today!



Get a whole new perspective at the Introduction to Perspectives Workshop on April 18 & 19 at the Pike Road Arts Center (944 Wallahatchie Rd)! Artist Charles Payne will guide participants as they learn and utilize different perspective techniques.

Learning perspective is an excellent opportunity to relearn seeing. Perspective uses different methods to create a scene with a feeling of depth and clarity of relationships between the objects in it. From 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. on April 18 & 19, artists will mainly practice Geometric Perspective (including 1, 2, and multi-point perspective), but will also touch on other topics: finding the vanishing point, Size Diminution Perspective, Aerial Perspective, and other

perspective methods. Artists will be provided with a booklet to help remember the lessons.


About the Artist: Charles D. Payne Jr. started his art career in the animation industry in 1984. Charles' experience centered on background design, a perspective-intensive job. Charles is a formally trained artist who graduated from MICA in Baltimore. He has shared his knowledge and experience teaching storyboarding and sketching at the Cogswell Polytechnical College in San Jose, California.

Join us on April 25 for a Pond Management Workshop, led by Rusty Wright, Extension Specialist and Auburn University School of Fisheries, Aquaculture and Aquatic Sciences Associate Professor, and Lynn Dickinson, Regional Extension Agent! This workshop will take place at the Pike Road Agriculture, Recreation, & Performing Arts Park (6281 Trotman Road) from 10 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Managing your pond can be tricky, so together we will cover weed issues, fertilization, stocking fish, and more! We will also cover wildlife issues, such as beaver and otter control. If you have pond weeds that need to be identified or if you would like your pond water tested, please bring a sample to the workshop. This workshop will

be held in a classroom & outdoors at a pond! We will provide a tent, water and light snacks, but come prepared with a chair, sunscreen, sunglasses, or any other items you may need!
