Recycle your Live Christmas Trees Through Jan. 9!

Beginning Tuesday, Dec. 26, there will be a designated <u>Christmas Tree Recycling</u> area in the parking lot of Pike Road Founders Station (4902 Pike Rd) near the intersection of Pike & Meriwether Roads for residents to drop off their UNDECORATED, LIVE trees. Trees can be dropped off for future use in animal habitats! If you have a use for a live, undecorated tree, you are welcome to pick one up.

Since 1993, Alabama Power has re-purposed and re-cycled over 60,000 Christmas Trees to build fish habitat for its Fish Habitat Enhancement program on Alabama Power Company managed reservoirs. In addition to using trees, artificial structures have been utilized as well.

Unleash Your Inner Artist! Water-Soluble Oil Painting Workshop on Jan. 18 - 19

Learn to create with water-soluble oil paint, a high-quality alternative paint that allows artists to work without the harsh solvents used with traditional oil paints, with Craig Reynolds at our <u>Water-Soluble Oil Painting Workshop</u> on Jan. 18 & 19, 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. daily at the Pike Road Arts Center (944 Wallahatchie Rd)!

Many artists enjoy the speed that comes from



working with water-soluble oil paints. These paints dry considerably faster than traditional oils, though not as fast as acrylics. Artist Craig Reynolds, who started using water-soluble oil paints when he realized he had an allergic reaction to the solvents used in painting with traditional oils, finds that using water-soluble oils en plein air painting allows him to quickly develop finished pieces, which is a plus when "chasing the shadows!"

Join us on Thursday, January 25, from 4 - 6 p.m. at the Pike Road Agriculture, Recreation, & Performing Arts Park (6281 Trotman Rd), to learn about bluebirds and how to encourage them to live near you at <u>"Home Tweet Home":</u> <u>Bluebird House Workshop.</u> Participants will get to learn all they need to know about the bluebirds living in our area before creating their own bluebird house to take home!

Carrie Threadgill, Non-Game Wildlife Program Coordinator for Alabama Wildlife & Freshwater Fisheries, will guide us through bluebird identification, breeding behavior, and habitat preferences before assisting us in creating our personal bluebird houses. Together, we will learn best practices for the installation and

location of our birdhouses, as well as feeding techniques and potential predator issues. Participants will receive all supplies necessary for their birdhouse.
