# YOU Can Assist Local Families Through Summer Feeding Program!





This spring, join us for another round of the <a href="Pysanky Egg Dyeing Workshops">Pysanky Egg Dyeing Workshops</a> on March 22 & 23 at the Pike Road Arts Center (944 Wallahatchie Rd). These were so popular last year, there was no way we could go without!

The Pysanky technique features beeswax designs applied to the surface of eggs, which are then dipped in special dyes to create intricate and vibrant keepsakes. This three-hour class is suitable for ages 12+, and participants will take home as many pysanky as they can create! Tuition is \$40 per person and includes ALL materials.
