

**Minutes of Pike Road Town Council Regular Meeting  
Monday, March 9, 2026|6:00 PM**

Councilman Steindorff called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Councilman Fuhrman opened the meeting in prayer. Councilman Steindorff led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Council members present were Doug Fuhrman, Rob Steindorff, Marcus Robinson, and Mim Whatley. Mayor Stone and Angie Bradsher were absent. A quorum was noted.

Consideration was given to the minutes for the regular meeting on February 25, 2026. Councilman Robinson made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilwoman Whatley seconded. Unanimous consent was given. The minutes were accepted as presented.

Reports

Planning

Senior Planner, Darrell Rigsby, noted that the next step following the approval of the Comp Plan is the regulation updates. Rigsby noted that once those updates are complete, we would begin public meetings to share them.

Old Business

The only item of old business was **Ordinance 2026-0612 Annexation of 1098 Chaseway Drive**. Councilwoman Whatley made a motion to approve **Ordinance 2026-0612 Annexation of 1098 Chaseway Drive**. New Business

The first item of new business was **Ordinance 2026-\_\_\_\_\_ Franchise Agreement with Spectrum Southeast, LLC**. Town Clerk, Lisa Burke, gave a review of the item to the council noting that it is a renewal of the previous one that recently expired. The agreement had a few slight changes but will still include the maximum Franchise Fees of 5%. This was considered the first reading of the ordinance, and it will be on the agenda at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

The last item of new business was **Ordinance 2026-\_\_\_\_\_ Annexation of 581 Parks Road**. The owner was not present to answer any questions of the council. This was considered the first reading of the ordinance, and it will be on the agenda at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

Other Business

Councilwoman Whatley shared a Discretionary Fund request on behalf of Councilwoman Bradsher. It will support a campaign for Cancer Wellness Foundation of Central Alabama and multiple Pike Road residents who are participating in the campaign. Bradsher is requesting \$1750 from the fund. Councilwoman Whatley made a motion to approve the expenditure. Councilman Fuhrman seconded. The expenditure was approved and we will do a presentation at the next council meeting.

With no further business at hand, Councilwoman Whatley made a motion to adjourn at 6:10 PM. Councilman Fuhrman seconded the motion. Unanimous consent was given. The meeting was adjourned.
