# Minutes of Pike Road Town Council Regular Meeting Monday, March 10, 2025|6:00 PM Pike Road Town Hall

Councilman Rob Steindorff called the meeting to order at 6:03 PM. Councilman Dunn opened the meeting in prayer. Mayor Stone led the Pledge of Allegiance.

## **Planning**

A Preliminary/Final Plat for subdividing 19.63 acres into two lots in Rolling Hills and the Development Plan for a Dental Office on Emma Court. Both items were approved.

Senior Planner, Darrell Rigsby, thanked the council for attending the work session for the Comp Plan update. Rigsby noted that once the final draft is complete, there will be a public meeting for review before the Planning Commission and Town Council take action to adopt.
