

New Garbage Service Provider for Town of Pike Road Residents

On June 1, 2018 AMWASTE will be the new garbage service provider for Town of Pike Road residents. Beginning May 14, AMWASTE will distribute new 96-gallon roll-out garbage carts for your homes and businesses.

AMWASTE will provide the following services:

Weekly Garbage Collection

- AMWASTE will conduct waste collection no earlier than 7:00 a.m. and no later than 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. On weeks containing holidays, waste may also be collected on Saturdays.
- Recognized holidays for which service <u>may</u> be delayed include: New Year's Day, Memorial Day*1,
 Independence Day, MLK Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If a holiday falls on a
 scheduled route day, that route will be serviced the following day. Service will be delayed one day for
 the rest of the holiday week.
 - o For example, if Monday is a holiday, the Monday route will be serviced on Tuesday, the Tuesday route will be serviced on Wednesday, and so on until the week is completed with Friday routes being serviced on Saturday.

Weekly Yard Waste Removal

- Yard waste, limited to one cubic yard, will be removed once a week on your garbage collection day. Small, loose items **must** be bagged, and limbs **must** be bundled and cut to the following specifications: 1 yard x 1 yard x 1 yard. One (1) yard is equal to three (3) feet.
 - Please see the illustration and description of a cubic yard provided on the following page.
- "Yard Waste" refers to any cuttings or trimmings from trees, shrubs, lawns, or other similar materials.
 Limbs cannot exceed five (5) inches in diameter or four (4) feet in length.

Rates and Specifications

- The service rate is \$55.20 per quarter for one (1) Cart per Residential or Commercial Unit. Additional carts will be supplied by request at a cost of \$8.25 each per quarter, with a limit of three (3) Carts per Residential or Commercial Unit.
- Additional services such as private drive access requests will be considered and priced separately.

Cart and Yard Waste Location Specifications

Please place each Cart and Yard Waste Bag or Bundle curbside within five feet of the curb. Curbside
refers to that portion of right-of-way adjacent to paved or traveled public roadways (including alleys)
along established mail routes.

^{1*}Memorial Day weekend falls on the first service week. AMWASTE will service Thursday customers on Friday, June 1st with Friday customers serviced on Saturday, June 2nd.

In addition to weekly garbage collection, AMWASTE will remove up to one cubic yard of yard waste on your collection day.

What's a cubic yard?

- A cubic yard is the volume of a box that is one yard long, one yard wide, and one yard high.
- One yard is equal to three feet, so you could fit 3 x 3 = 9 *cubic foot* boxes on the bottom of a *cubic yard* box.
- To fill the box, you need 3 such layers, so there are 3 x 3 x 3 = 27 cubic feet in a cubic yard.

What's yard waste?

• Yard waste refers to any cuttings or trimmings from trees, shrubs, lawns, or other similar materials. Limbs cannot exceed five (5) inches in diameter or four (4) feet in length.
