
This designation included \$125,000 in seed money, which will forward a special innovative project bolstering a healthy workforce in our community.

Together, we will work with fondant and multiple cake sizes to create edible art! These festive creations will be the perfect touch for


your holiday events. Participants will receive multiple cakes and all necessary supplies.
